

WKYC Announces New Memorial, Tribute Opportunities

(September 14, 2020) MARION, Ky. – Western Kentucky Youth Camp’s new commemorative bench swings and bunk beds are offered through the Stronger Together Campaign.

Western Kentucky Youth Camp is offering the public the opportunity to donate funds for a commemorative cabin swing or bunk bed in a new girls’ cabin. Born out of a request by a donor to memorialize the life of a loved one using a cabin swing, WKYC formalized these new dedications as part of its *Stronger Together Campaign*, which invites others to honor, remember, or thank a loved one through this program.

Donors can have expressions of care and concern displayed on customized plaques for the life of the swing or bed, which is often several decades. A minimum of \$500 is needed to dedicate a bunk bed, and a minimum of \$1,000 is needed to dedicate a cabin swing.
